Classes will be assigned after entries close, providing limits have not been reached from Regular and Optional entries

NOTE: Classes will run in Jump Height Order — Low to High Both Days

UDX Class - When entries are limited in the Open B and /or Utility B classes, a club must designate a UDX class in the premium list, Dogs entered in this UDX class would be entered in both Open B and Utility B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either the Open B or the Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

All entries must be legible and have a jump height if entered in classes that use jumps or it will be refused.

Note: Highest means Highest Scoring. Dog means either sex. Entries in Non-Regular classes are only eligible for non-regular class awards. No trophies will be shipped. All trophies not awarded or claimed before 5 PM on Sunday become property of the Central Florida Obedience Dog Club. Persons claiming prizes may be required to show an armband for identification.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

CLOSING DATE for entries is Noon, Wednesday, March 5, 2025 after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed per move up clause below. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees. No telephone or fax entries can be accepted. **EXPRESS DELIVERY services must include SIGNATURE WAIVER permitting them to be left WITHOUT recipient's signature.**

ENTRIES ARE LIMITED to eight hours of judging time per day, per judge Regular Class entries, including the UDX class, will be given first priority followed by the Optional Titling Classes followed by the Non-Regular Classes.

Included in the entry fees: A \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.50 Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog will be collected by the American Kennel Club for all Regular AKC classes (fees do not apply to Non-Regular Classes). A Recording Fee of \$0.50 will also be collected for the first entry of each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience. These fees are collected by the show

giving club and are paid to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC Rule Effective January 1, 2024)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, unsafe weather conditions or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Transfers (formerly Move-ups)

- After a dog earns a title, a transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

For a written request regarding a transfer for an ineligible dog and handler team from the "A" class to the "B" class at the same level, please refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16b

UDX Class - When entries are limited in the Open B and /or Utility B classes, a club must designate a UDX class in the premium list. Dogs entered in this UDX class would be entered in both Open B and Utility B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either the Open B or the Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL LOCATION:

Orlando Dog Training Club 6357 All American Blvd, Orlando, FL

From the South on I-4: Heading East (North) on I-4, exit at Lee Road and head West (left). Turn right on Edgewater Drive, right at the light onto All American Blvd. Building will be on the right on the curve.

From North of Orlando on I-4: Heading West (South) on I-4, exit at Lee Road and head West (right), Turn right on Edgewater Drive, right at the light onto All American Blvd. Building will be on the right on the curve.

From South Orlando using 441/Orange Blossom Trail: Head North, cross over Lee Road, turn right onto All American Blvd., cross over Edgewater Drive at the light and building will be on the right.

From North Orlando using 441/Orange Blossom Trail: Head South, turn left on All American Blvd., cross over Edgewater Drive at the light and building will be on the right.

From North Orlando, Maitland, Altamonte Springs etc.: Using Maitland Blvd from either direction, head South on 434 (Forest City Road). Turn right on All American Blvd. Building will be on your left

RANDOM REWARD CLASSES

(Same Rules apply for each class - Novice, Open, Utility)

The Random Reward Novice Class exercises will be performed as Novice class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged & not penalized. Handler may give additional commands & encouragement without being penalized. Handlers will not be allowed to hold up a class with excessive encouragement & Judges will have the option to end any exercise. Each handler may choose to: Skip 1 exercise or Choose to do that exercise but the handler may now be allowed to leave position anywhere in that exercise, go toward the dog & reward with a toy. (Toys MAY NOT make noise or be an item that will roll into another ring). When checking in, the handler must inform the judge or steward which exercise will be selected to skip or selected to go & reward the dog. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular class. The Judge will call commands exactly as in the regular class.

VACCINATIONS ETC. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

BITCHES that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee less \$4.00 per dog per class refunded upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging on the day of the trial.

ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS

* Misconduct at hotels/motels may result in an Event Committee hearing. * Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs at the ODTTC Training Building and at hotels/motels. Your continued responsibility and respect allow hotels / motels to continue to work with CFODC so we can provide you with the best venue possible. Please relieve your dogs in marked areas outside and be careful to not allow your dog to mark or urinate inside or on the buildings, trash cans and cars nearby. Trash cans are placed throughout the grounds-please use them. * The CFODC Trial is located in a smoke-free building. * Per AKC rules no dogs are allowed in the show rings for practice at any time. * Please bring your own chairs and crates. * Ex-pens are NOT permitted indoors at our trials because of building size limitations. * No dogs may be left in the building after 6:00 pm or overnight.

CFODC and ODTTC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, visitors, children, dogs or property. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parents or guardian. Parents or Guardians must exercise control and restraint over their children at all times. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT
